Rights Respecting Schools

The Pupil Council Global Citizenship Leadership Group are nearing the end of their agreed action to create their 3D sculpture which represents the pupil voice of Fordyce Primary School and its relationship with the local community. This is proving to be a very successful enterprise. All the pupils in this group have developed their skills for life building their confidence to interact with local businesses and help them identify possible future career pathways. The group have thoroughly enjoyed working in the Joiner's Workshop with Ewan Hay, workshop volunteer who has shared his technical teacher expertise with the children. On Wednesday 15th June this group will be painting the final elements of the structure with the support of Mr Anderson, our local artist, who has been truly invaluable to this project! Day One of the planting of the structure will take place on Monday 20th June where the group will be working closely with Aberdeenshire Council's Landscape Services. Tuesday 21st will see the Sculpture being placed into the ground, and the children will only be involved in the filming at this point.

Please note this group will require old clothes and shoes for the next two weeks to allow them to complete these tasks.

On the morning of Friday 24th June we will welcome Maxine Jolly, Rights Respecting School's Strategic Lead, UNICEF and her colleague to Fordyce Primary School for our Level 2 Inspection. As mentioned at the recent Parent Council meeting, two parents will be invited to attend a meeting to reflect on our Rights Respecting journey.
